

SECT. 193. Every person who shall wilfully and maliciously destroy, mutilate, deface, injure, or remove any tomb, monument, gravestone, or other structure placed within any cemetery, graveyard, or place of public burial, or any fences, railing, or other work, for the protection or ornament of any tomb, monument, gravestone, or other structure aforesaid, or of any cemetery-lot within any cemetery, or shall wilfully and maliciously destroy, remove, cut, break, or injure, any tree, shrub, or plant, within any cemetery, or shall discharge any gun or other fire-arms within said cemetery, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in a common jail not exceeding six months, or by such fine and imprisonment both, at the discretion of the court having cognizance of the offence.

SECT. 194. Nothing contained in the preceding section shall be construed so as to prevent the discharge of guns or other fire-arms, by any military company, by order of any commissioned officer of such company, while under arms and in the performance of funeral obsequies.
